

The following "Codes" are words or phrases that are used at this facility to communicate specific situations that may arise. In the event of an emergency situation, a plain-language emergency code will be used to notify the appropriate individuals to initiate an immediate and appropriate response based on the hospital emergency operations plan. The emergency code activation may or may not include widespread notification, based on the incident and established emergency procedure. Upon hearing the announcement or being told by a supervisor all employees will respond in accordance with the hospital policy and /or the department's specific plan that has been developed for that particular emergency.
